Savannah's annual Juneteenth Fine Arts Festival is a showcase for music art and culture from around the world. This festival is a multi-day affair, with cultural events and different venues to get your fill.

Alongside the group show, resident artist Julia Roland had the opening for a show titled "The Duality of Self" which is in Gallery C. About three months ago, Cedar House Gallery opened up one of the studio spaces to a queer artist. They had two months to create a body of work, and this month, June, they're getting to showcase that body of work.

"They actually entered by submitting a proposal about the body of work, how it relates to the LGBTQIA+ community, and how they plan to get the message across," Cole said. "We had about 12 entries...and we really wanted the people who didn't get accepted to get involved, so we opened up Spectrum."

Duality of Self is a collection of paintings that loosely explore the themes of human complexity and conflicting emotions or behaviors, Roland said. She said she was inspired by the stereotypes assigned to her astrological sign, Gemini.

"There is more than one way to be yourself," Roland said. "This exhibition pushes to encourage the malleability and fluidity of humans in general, regardless of astrological placements."

Stonewall Block Party

A slight change is coming to SPC's annual Stonewall Block Party: it's taking place completely inside Starland Yard. Instead of taking on Bull St., as was tradition, the party is moving. One, because closing down the streets for the party is particularly expensive, and two, because there's seating, shade and food options.

"It will no longer be on the street, with Port-a-potties, and it's a much more manageable place for our seniors and people living with different abilities and disabilities," Bell said.

The party will be on Saturday, June 28 from 2 p.m. to 10 p.m. For pride this month, Bell said they want to highlight the new programs, like the inclusive healing clinic which provides free gynecology appointments that supplies hormone replacement therapy. There's also the monthly event Cheers Queers on the fourth Thursday of every month in Starland. Events like the gallery, he said, are great because pride can be very party-oriented.

"Sometimes they revolve around drinking and partying," Bell said. "And here we give lots of options for people to feel comfortable experiencing pride at whatever their comfort level."

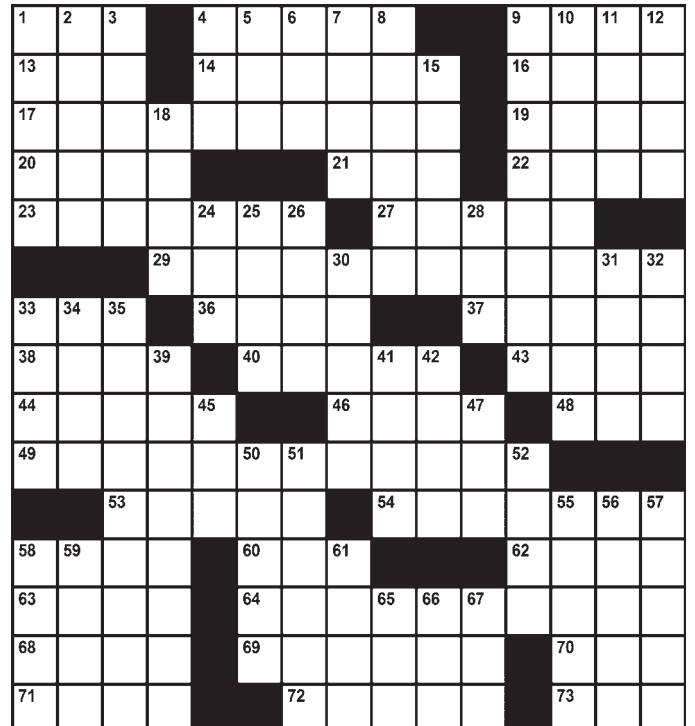
